

Pentecost craft activities for children

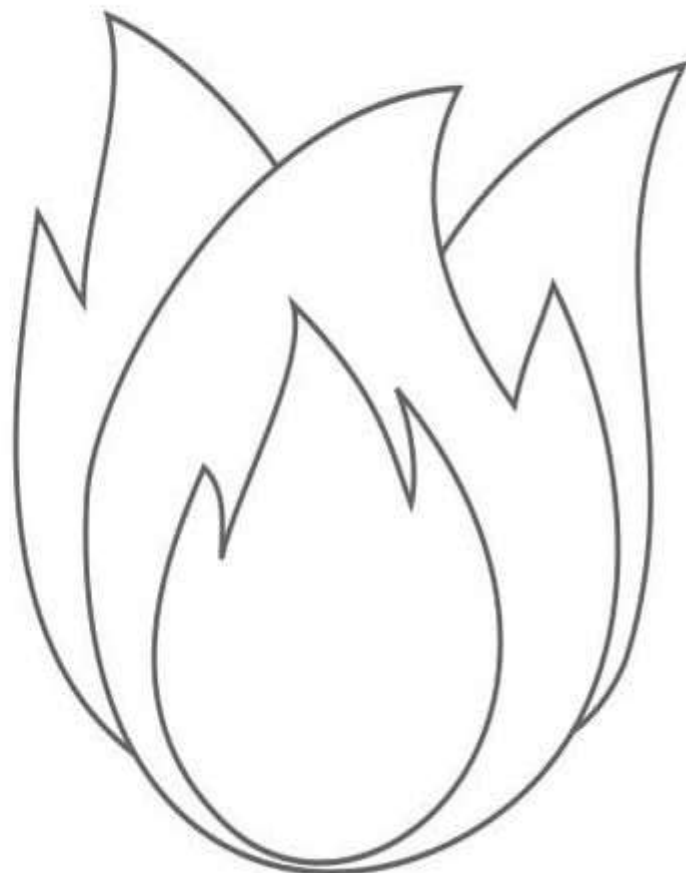
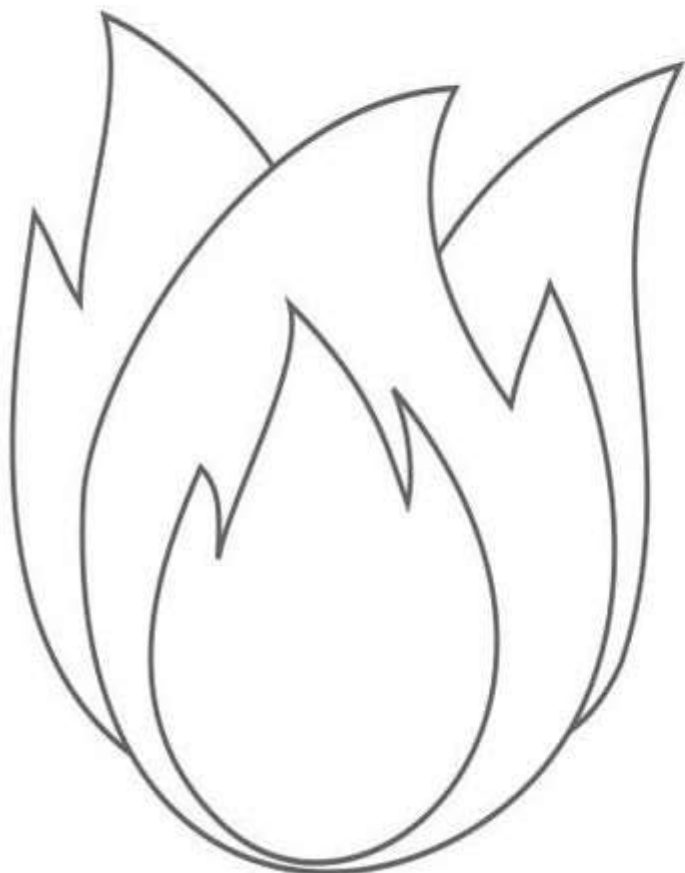
Flame headband



Needed: strips of card, stapler, red, yellow and orange paper or card, scissors, glue.

Join strips of card together to make a band to fit around each child's head and help them staple it together.

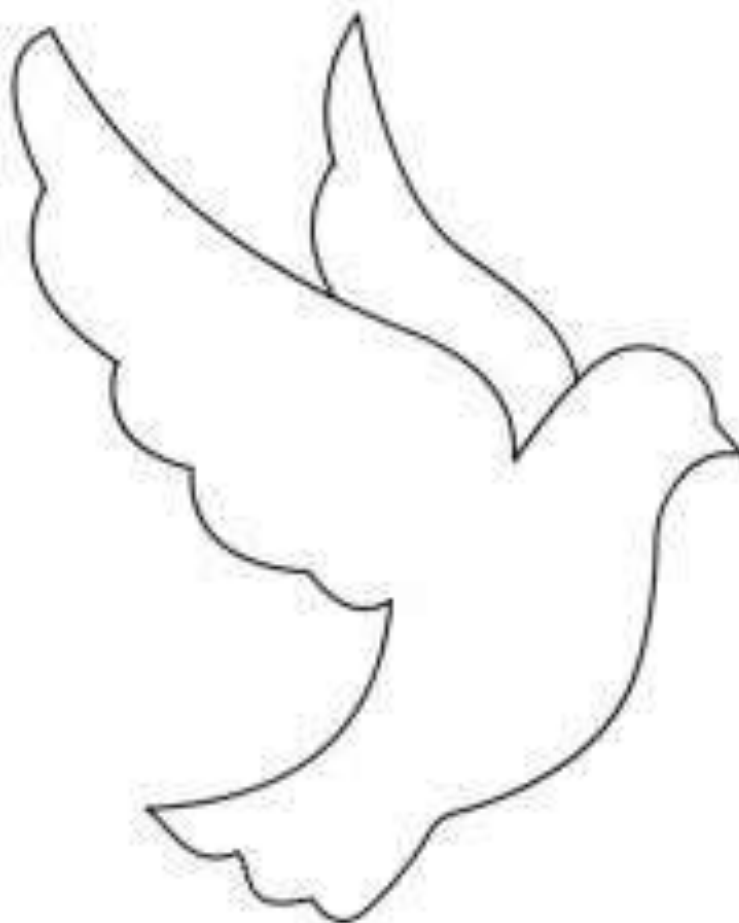
Ask the children to cut flame shapes out of the coloured paper and glue them to the headband or for younger children pre-cut the shapes and ask them to glue them onto the band. The flames could also be decorated with glitter!



Flame streamer balloon



Needed: balloon, string, bamboo cane, white, red, orange and yellow paper, glue for balloon, red tissue paper, dove shape (below and also for blow painting)



Breeze ball

Needed: piece of card thin enough to cut through, pencil, a compass or something to draw a circle, ruler, colouring pens/glitter for decoration, scissors.

Cut out a circle 12 – 14cm in diameter and mark up as shown. The ball can be decorated at this stage. • Carefully cut along the 12 solid lines starting from the centre (snip in the centre to start or use a craft knife) • Fold alternate triangles up and down, as shown, all around the circle. There will be 6 triangles pointing up and 6 pointing down. Drop the ball on the ground where a breeze can catch it and watch it roll along!
