

## Updates of National Mission Commission of Nepal March, 2015

## **Missionary Training**

I am very much pleased to inform you that 13<sup>th</sup> batch of Missionary Training has begun from 1<sup>st</sup> of March. The students will be graduating in the last week of May.



We thank the Lord and partnering churches, who have sent their missionary candidates to be

trained for 3 months Residential Training. After the Training the Students will be sent out to the unreached areas of Nepal and India. We have over 100 missionaries on the field planting the churches. The training is focused on Cross-cultural and Holistic Mission so that missionaries will integrate the holistic approach to reach out and transform the communities through to Love of Christ

## **Prison Ministry**

An Evangelistic Meeting was held in Bhairahawa Prison on 26<sup>th</sup> of February. I thank the Lord for the opportunity to share the Gospel of Jesus Christ in two different cells of the prison. There were altogether about 400 prisoners who were able to hear the Good News. Prison officials were so kind to us who allowed us to enter into the prison and helped gather the inmates.

On that occasion, the National Mission Commission of Nepal distributed the blankets and sweaters to the prisons. I thank the Lord for enabling us to start a



church service in the prison.

I was locked up for sometimes inside the prison, because I kept talking with inmate and my team thought that I went out, but

when they did not see me out, they came back looking for me, by then the security had already locked the door of entrance. By their request, I was let go out of the prison.

## **Slum Children Ministry:**

At this moment we have 3 centers where a total of 125 Children attends regularly. The children are taught Bible Stories, Songs, their textbook and fed every day.



I am sorry to tell you that the last week's storm has blown away the one of the center's roof. The room was flooded which caused us to discontinue the classes for for a few days. We are in the process of repairing the roof. Kindly join us in your prayers.
