Weekly Coffee and Prayer

on Thursday mornings during term time we meet from 9.15am for a short but meaningful time of simple liturgy, open discussion and informal prayers, with a mug of tea or coffee.

Prayer Network

a confidential WhatsApp group to mobilise praying people in response to requests.

FaceBook Group

an online space for people to share faith affirming encouragements in a whole host of ways -poems, articles, Bible verses, prayers, images. A way of doing church remotely and a great resource for those who find attending a service difficult.

Mid-week Small Groups

a chance to explore faith deeper with others regularly in caring, friendly, supportive smaller gathering meeting in someone's home.
