### **Archives for Church Open day (May 2017)**

#### **Mulbarton's Medieval Font..**

...has stood in Mulbarton Church for centuries, with 1000s of Parishioners over the years being baptised in it - **the first recorded** one (as seen in the Archives brought along from the Records Office by NRO Officer Jonathan Draper to the Open Day on 13th May 2017)

was of **Allen Anstell** (son of Peter Anstell) on the **18th October 1547**

With Victorian boggles and deterioration however, the font is not surprisingly in need of repair - £10,000 sounds like a lot on money but, for 1000 years of service, that's only £10 per year!

The Church Open Day already mentioned, was an opportunity to raise awareness of this need and for villagers and others to come and see for themselves, and possibly even consider helping to fund this historical feature which is still used today. ### Harvest House

Anyone can book Harvest House.

Harvest House is situated south of Mulbarton Church, and shares an entry with the Long Barn. It was purchased by Mulbarton Church in 1993. A programme of renovation and adaptation has made this house an attractive venue for Counselling sessions, Tearcraft Sales, training days, Music and Drama group rehearsals and more



The ground-floor meeting-room seats about 36 people. Adjacent is a large well-equipped kitchen and a toilet, with facilities for those with disabilities. There is a prayer room upstairs and meeting-rooms which can accommodate small groups, and have superb views over Mulbarton Common. For more information or for bookings e-mail Caroline Dunlop
