Baptism of George Henry Lewis Morrison:

The minister prays

Heavenly Father, by the power of your Holy Spirit
you give to your faithful people new life in the water of baptism.
Guide and strengthen us by the same Spirit,
that we who are born again may serve you in faith and love,
and grow into the full stature of your Son, Jesus Christ,
who is alive and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit
now and for ever.

All: Amen.

The minister addresses the whole congregation:

Faith is the gift of God to his people.
In baptism the Lord is adding to our
number those whom he is calling.
People of God, will you welcome this
child and uphold him in his new life in Christ?

All: With the help of God, we will.

The minister addresses the parents and godparents:
Parents and godparents, the Church
receives this child with joy.
Today we are trusting God for his growth in faith.
Will you pray for him,
draw him by your example into the community of faith
and walk with him in the way of Christ?

Parents and Godparents:
With the help of God, we will.

In baptism George begins his journey in faith.
You speak for him today.
Will you care for him, and help him to take his place
within the life and worship of Christ's Church?

Parents and Godparents:
With the help of God, we will.

A large candle is lit. The president addresses the parents and godparents:

In baptism, God calls us out of darkness into his marvellous light.
To follow Christ means dying to sin and rising to new life with him.

Therefore I ask:

Do you turn to Christ?
I turn to Christ.

Do you repent of your sins?
I repent of my sins.

Do you renounce evil?
I renounce evil.

The Signing of the Cross:

The minister make the sign of the cross on the forehead of George, saying:

George, Christ claims you for his own. Receive the sign of his cross.

George, do not be ashamed to confess the faith of Christ crucified.

**All: Fight valiantly as a disciple of Christ against sin, the world and the devil,
And remain faithful to Christ to the end of your life.**

George receives a blessing, with these words:

May almighty God deliver you from the powers of darkness, restore in you the image of his glory, and lead you in the light and obedience of Christ.

All: Amen.

A Reading: Want you to be happy

I want you to be happy. I want you to fill your heart with feelings of wonder and to be full of courage and hope. I want you to be full of friendship that is a treasure - and the kind of love that is beautiful forever. I wish you contentment: the sweet, quiet, inner kind that comes around and never goes away.

I want you to have hopes and have them all come true.
I want you to make the most of this moment in time.
I want you to have a real understanding of how unique and rare you truly are.
I want to remind you that the sun may disappear for a while, but it never forgets to shine.

I want you to have faith. May you have feelings that are shared from heart to heart, simple pleasures amidst this complex world, and wonderful goals that are within your grasp.
May the words you listen to say the things you need to hear. And may a cheerful face lovingly look back at you when you happen to glance in your mirror.

I wish you the insight to see your inner and outer beauty.
I wish you sweet dreams. I want you to have times when you feel like singing and dancing and laughing out loud.

I want you to be able to make your good times better and your hard times easier to handle. I want you to have millions of moments when you find satisfaction in the things you do so wonderfully. And I wish I could find a way to tell you - in untold ways - how important you are to me.

Of all the things I'll be wishing for, wherever you are and whatever I may do, there will never be a day in my life when I won't be wishing the best...for you.

Prayer over the water:

*The minister, candidate, parents and Godparents gather at the baptismal font.
The minister stands before the water of baptism and says:*

Praise God who made heaven and earth,

All: who keeps his promise for ever.

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

All: It is right to give thanks and praise.

We thank you, almighty God, for the gift of water
to sustain, refresh and cleanse all life.

Over water the Holy Spirit moved in the beginning of creation.

Through water you led the children of Israel
from slavery in Egypt to freedom in the Promised Land.

In water your Son Jesus received the baptism of John
and was anointed by the Holy Spirit as the Messiah, the Christ,
to lead us from the death of sin to newness of life.

We thank you, Father, for the water of baptism.

It symbolises our burial with Christ in his death;

Our sharing in his resurrection; And our rebirth by the Holy Spirit.

Therefore, in joyful obedience to your Son,

we baptize into his fellowship those who come to him in faith.

Now sanctify this water that, by the power of your Holy Spirit,
those who are baptised in it may know cleansing and new birth.

Renewed in your image, may they walk by the light of faith
and continue for ever in the risen life of Jesus Christ our Lord;
to whom with you and the Holy Spirit be all honour and glory,
now and for ever.

All: Amen.

The Profession of Faith:

The minister addresses the congregation:

Brothers and sisters, I ask you to profess the faith of the Church.

Do you believe and trust in God the
Father, source of all being and life,
the one for whom we exist?

All: We believe and trust in him.

Do you believe and trust in his Son,
Jesus Christ, who redeemed the world?

All: We believe and trust in him.

Do you believe and trust in his Holy Spirit, who gives life to the people of God?

All: We believe and trust in him.

This is the faith of the Church.

All: This is our faith.

**We believe and trust in one God,
Father, Son and Holy Spirit.**

Amen.

The Baptism:

The ministers pour water on George, saying:

George Henry Lewis, I baptize you in the name of the Father,
and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

All: Amen.

May God, who has received you by baptism into his Church,
pour upon you the riches of his grace, that within the company of Christ's
pilgrim people you may daily be renewed by his anointing Spirit,
and come to the inheritance of the saints in glory.

All: Amen.

The minister addresses the congregation, parents and godparents, saying:

We have brought this child to baptism knowing that Jesus died and rose again
for him and trusting in the promise that God hears and answers prayer. We have
prayed that in Jesus Christ he will know the forgiveness of his sins and the new life
of the Spirit.

As he grows up, he will need the help and encouragement of the Christian
community, so that he may learn to know God in public worship and private
prayer, follow Jesus Christ in the life of faith, serve his neighbours after the
example of Christ, and in due course come to confirmation. Therefore let us
bear this child in our prayers and let us welcome him now.

The Welcome:

There is one Lord, one faith, one baptism.
By one Spirit we are all baptised into one body.

**All: We welcome you into the fellowship
of faith; we are children of the same
heavenly Father; we welcome you.**

Presentations:

A certificate, holding cross and children's bible are presented to the newly baptised with the words:

Receive this book. It is the good news of God's love. Take it as your guide.

A lit candle is presented to the newly baptised with the words:

You have received the light of Christ; walk in this light all the days of your life.

All: Shine as a light in the world to the glory of God the Father.

A prayer for Children & Carers

Faithful and loving God,
bless those who care for George and all children
and grant them your gifts of love,
wisdom and faith.
Pour upon them your healing
and reconciling love,
and protect their homes from all evil.
Fill them with the light of your presence
and establish them in the joy of your kingdom,
through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Bible Reading: Mark 7:1-8; 14-15; 21-23
