²⁵ Large crowds were traveling with Jesus, and turning to them he said: ²⁶ "If anyone comes to me and does not hate father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters—yes, even their own life—such a person cannot be my disciple.

²⁷ And whoever does not carry their cross and follow me cannot be my disciple.

²⁸ "Suppose one of you wants to build a tower. Won't you first sit down and estimate the cost to see if you have enough money to complete it? ²⁹ For if you lay the foundation and are not able to finish it, everyone who sees it will ridicule you, ³⁰ saying, 'This person began to build and wasn't able to finish.'

³¹ "Or suppose a king is about to go to war against another king. Won't he first sit down and consider whether he is able with ten thousand men to oppose the one coming against him with twenty thousand? ³² If he is not able, he will send a delegation while the other is still a long way off and will ask for terms of peace.

³³ In the same way, those of you who do not give up everything you have cannot be my disciples.

Pakistan Flooding – Tearfund Appeal

Tearfund Prayer Pointers:

- The Disasters Emergency Committee, of which Tearfund is a part, has launched an emergency appeal. Pray that this raises the funds required to reach the most vulnerable people.
- Pray for those who have lost their loved ones. Ask God to draw near to them and comfort them in this time of grief.

- Pray for provision for people who have lost their belongings, homes, livestock and livelihoods. Ask God to give them courage and strength.
- Pray for people with mobility issues, for pregnant and nursing mothers, and for unaccompanied children, all of whom are especially vulnerable at this time.
- Pray for protection from illness, as flooding brings the risk of waterborne diseases.
- Pray for wisdom, energy and resources for local, national and international leaders as they respond to this crisis.
- As the crisis continues, pray for strength and energy for healthcare workers and other first-responders.
- Pray that governments around the world will take the immediate, strong action that is necessary to tackle the climate crisis and support vulnerable countries.
