A song of God's vineyard in Isaiah 5 verses 1 to 7:

I will sing for the one I love, a song about his vineyard:

My loved one had a vineyard on a fertile hillside.

He dug it over and cleared it of stones

and planted it with the choicest vines.

He built a watchtower in it, and cut out a winepress as well.

Then he looked for a crop of good grapes,

but it yielded only bad fruit.

"Now, you dwellers in Jerusalem and people of Judah, judge between me and my vineyard.

CONFESSION - based on Isaiah 6:

A Parable of God's Vineyard: Matthew 21 verses 33 to 46:

(Jesus is speaking to the chief priests, elders and Pharisees)

"Listen to another parable:

There was a landowner who planted a vineyard. He put a wall round it, dug a winepress in it and built a watchtower. Then he rented the vineyard to some tenants and went away on a journey. When the harvest time approached, he sent his servants to the tenants to collect his fruit.

The tenants seized his servants; they beat one, killed another, and stoned a third. Then he sent other servants to them, more than the first time, and the tenants treated them in the same way. Last of all, he sent his son to them. "They will respect my son," he said.

But when the tenants saw the son, they said to each other, "This is the heir! Come, let us kill him and take his inheritance." So they took him and threw him out of the vineyard and killed him.

Therefore, when the owner of the vineyard comes, what will he do to those tenants?"

"He will bring those wretches to a wretched end," they replied, "and he will rent out the vineyard to other tenants, who will give him his share of the crop at harvest time."

Jesus said to them, "Have you never read the Scriptures: 'The stone the builders rejected has become the capstone; the Lord has done this, and it is marvellous in our eyes'?"

"Therefore I tell you that the Kingdom of God will be taken away from you and given to a people who will produce its fruit. He who falls on this stone will be broken to pieces, but he on whom it falls will be crushed."

When the chief priests and the Pharisees heard Jesus' parables they knew he was talking about them. They looked for a way to arrest him, but they were afraid of the crowd because the people held that he was a prophet.

Jesus speaks about the Vine: John 15 verses 1-4:

"I am the true vine, and my Father is the gardener. He cuts off every branch in me that bears no fruit, while every branch that does bear fruit he prunes so that it will be even more fruitful. You are already clean because of the word I have spoken to you. Remain in me, and I will remain in you. No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must remain in the vine. Neither can you bear fruit unless you remain in me."
