- <sup>13</sup> He waters the mountains from his upper chambers; the land is satisfied by the fruit of his work.
- <sup>14</sup>He makes grass grow for the cattle, and plants for people to cultivate bringing forth food from the earth:
- wine that gladdens human hearts, oil to make their faces shine, and bread that sustains their hearts.
